## **Collection Policy**

Please can we remind everyone of our collection policy which can be found on our website at <a href="https://www.sawstonnursery.org">www.sawstonnursery.org</a>

Parents should advise the nursery by telephone if they know they are going to be late for collection however there will still be a charge and you should be aware of this to avoid any confusion. In the event of late collection an additional fee will be charged (currently £10 for up to ten minutes and £5 for every subsequent five minutes. An e mail will be sent to the parent advising of the late charge which will be added to the next relevant invoice.

#### A Polite Reminder

Please can you remember to supply your child with spare clothes, a water bottle, sun hat and sun cream and ensure all are labelled with your child's name to prevent loss.

Also, if you wish for an in depth handover about your child's day in the nursery please can you ensure that you arrive before 6pm and we can happily make the time to talk. If you arrive at 6pm this is very difficult for the staff team as the nursery shuts down at this time.
