A Message from the Bluebell & Buttercup Room

Welcome to Bluebell and Buttercup Room.

November brings firework fun into the Buttercup and Bluebell Rooms. We are looking forward to offering a wide range of colourful, stimulating activities to create our own magical fireworks with the children.

November also brings dark evenings so we will be exploring our 'In the Night Sky' theme. We will venture outside to look at the stars and moon and will be learning about what else we might see in the sky at night.

We will also be creating dark spaces in the setting enabling us to enjoy some wonderful sensory experiences with the children.

We would like to ask parent/carers to ensure they are bringing coats, gloves and shoes for the children now the weather has changed as it gets very chilly outside. Although we are lucky that our outdoor area is undercover, it still gets cold and damp.

<u>Polite Note</u>

If we could remind all parents to remove their shoes before they enter the room and remove your children's shoes. We would like to ask that all children bring in a pair of shoes to wear in the garden if your child is 'up and about' on their feet and to remember to bring in your child's water beaker, which will be familiar to them.

What's happening in the Daffodil Room?

Welcome to Daffodil Room.

During November, Daffodil room will continue focusing on Autumn time, through looking at the changes in the leaves. We will be exploring our senses through textured and messy play involving leaves, pumpkins and scented playdough. The other topics/themes in the room will be, fireworks night and Remembrance Day, creating beautiful pictures, rockets and poppies.

Please could we ask that all parents/carers remember to sign your child in and out of the nursery in line with Health and Safety and Safeguarding policies.

Please could you provide a pair of <u>named</u> wellington boots for your child so we can change into these whilst playing and exploring in the woodland area during our Outdoor Learning sessions.

A Message from Poppy Room

Welcome to Poppy Room.

In our room, we will be continuing with our autumn topic, exploring the texture of leaves, pinecones and other natural resources we can find. The children will also be looking at and talking about the changing colours outside at this time of the year. We hope to incorporate bonfire night and make our own colourful fireworks related art and share our own experiences and knowledge related to fireworks.

Children will be given the opportunity to make poppies, to help us remember the soldiers of the Second World War, Remembrance Day, whilst exploring and using a variety of materials.

Furthermore, Poppy Room will be using autumn to compare colours, shapes and sizes to support our exploration and curiosity skills further and compare similarities in objects we find.

When we 'go out and about' on our walks, we will talk about autumn and make connections with the use of stories about the weather changes and autumn animals. During our walks, the children will collect autumn objects to use in our sensory play and to create discussions and conversations about autumn time.

If Parents could bring in a <u>named</u> water bottle every day and remember to take it home for a wash at the end of the session, we would be grateful.

Furthermore, please could we have a pair of **named wellies** for your child and **warm clothing** for colder weather conditions.

Finally, please ensure your child has a couple of spare sets of clothes in their bag just in case your child gets wet during play or has an accident.

Welcome to Sunflower Room.

A busy few weeks in Sunflower room, with so much to explore and celebrate. Our topic of 'Room on the Broom' is the start of our journey whilst developing knowledge in 'Understanding the World', which is part of the Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. We thoroughly enjoyed our film night on Friday 25th October, celebrating Halloween with lots of witchy, spooky crafts and messy play. We hope all the children had a lot of fun and thank you all for coming along. We raised £65 in total, which will be used to purchase resources for the Sunflower Room. Thank you to everyone who supported this fun fundraising evening.

We also celebrated the Hindu festival of lights, Diwali, on Monday 28th October giving the children the opportunity to learn about different celebrations in the world.

Bonfire night on Tuesday 5th November is still to come and we are looking forward to sharing stories about this event. We will be listening to a simple story to support our understanding of customs and cultures and finally on Monday 11th November we will be walking to the War Memorial to lay our homemade poppies in remembrance of our soldiers who fought in the Second World War.

Can we please ask that you <u>return any borrowed clothes</u> as soon as possible. We have sent children home in lots of nursery clothes and our supplies are running low.

Please continue supporting your children in being independent in putting on socks and shoes and coats along with using the toilet, it really does help us out in the day. If parents could please remember to take home your child's water bottle every day for washing, this would be appreciated.
